His research interests include political parties, legislative behavior, public policy, and state politics. Colin Glennon is an Assistant Professor of Political Science at East Tennessee State University. His research interests focus on judicial behavior, the relationship between courts and other branches of government, and citizen perceptions of judicial legitimacy. He has previously published work in *Law and Social Inquiry*, *Politics and Policy* and *Judicature*.

Yan Gu is a Ph.D. candidate at Henry M. Jackson School of International Studies at University of Washington. Her research looks at state propaganda and public opinion on the Internet in authoritarian regimes, with an empirical focus on China. Before joining Jackson School, she was a journalist and commentator at *Changjiang Daily*, the official newspaper of Wuhan Municipal Committee of the Chinese Communist Party.

Drew Kurlowski is an Assistant Professor of Politics at Coastal Carolina University. He is also the Director of Data Analytics at the Dyer Institute for Leadership and Public Policy, and the Director of the American Studies program. His research and teaching interests focus on campaigns and elections, election law, political parties, southern politics, and American political thought. He holds an M.A. from the University of Virginia and a Ph.D. from the University of Missouri.

Satoshi Machida is an Associate Professor in the Department of Political Science at the University of Nebraska at Kearney. His research focuses on security issues focusing on nuclear weapons and nationalism in East Asia.

Mikel Norris is an Assistant Professor of Politics at Coastal Carolina University. His research examines judicial selection, gender and judicial decision making, and chief justice leadership on state supreme courts, among other topics. His work has been published in *Canadian Journal of Political Science*, and *Journal of Women, Politics & Policy*. He was the Paul D.
