The Program Committee of the APSA is making preparations for our eighth annual meeting. The meeting will be held on February 27 and 28, 1981, at De Gray State Park Lodge near Arkadelphia, Arkansas.

The principal speakers for this meeting will be Dr. Daniel Grant, President of Ouachita Baptist University, and Mayor Casey Laman of North Little Rock.
