Re: Tentative Program for Ninth Annual Meeting, Hotel Reservation Information and Cards and Other Bits and Pieces

The Ninth Annual Convention of the Arkansas Political Science Association will be held at the Hilton Hotel in Fayetteville, Arkansas, on February 26-27, 1982. Enclosed is a copy of the convention's tentative program for your perusal. Should you note errors, or know of any deletions or additions which are required, please inform me in order that changes may be made prior to the printing of the final convention program in late January, 1982.

Also enclosed is a brochure on and reservation card for the Hilton Hotel. As you will note on the reservation card there is a cut-off date of February 19, 1982, for receiving reservations. I urge you, however, to make your reservations well before that date as February 27, 1982, is the date of the last home game for the basketball Razorbacks and a large crowd can be expected in Fayetteville for that event. Please make clear on your reservation card whether you wish a room for the night of February 26, 1982, only, or if you plan on remaining in town to visit or attend the Razorback basketball game on the following night indicate on the reservation card that you want a room for the nights of February 26 and 27, 1982. For those who might wish to bring their family let me add that for children under 12 sharing their parents' room there is no extra charge. For those 12 and over there is an additional charge of \$10.00 per night.

Those presenting papers should have final copies of their presentations delivered to the panel chair and discussant(s) no later than February 12, 1982. To be considered for an Association award three (3) copies of the paper's final version must be received by the Awards Committee Chair (Darwin Gamble, ASU, State University, Arkansas 72467) no later than February 12, 1982.

Let me say again, for the Association, how happy we are to have meeting with us the Arkansas chapter of the American Society for Public Administration. The panel on Public Administration is being chaired by the President of that organization, Phillip Hoots. We hope this merging of people, ideas and information will continue in future years.
