Re: 1980 Program Seventh Annual Meeting Feb. 29-March 1

Date: February 12, 1980

Your 1980 program includes special features: the first panel exclusively for student papers; an international relations panel relating Arkansas to the world economy and including both academicians and practitioners; and two sessions dealing with the proposed Arkansas constitution. An unusual feature, there are three roundtables: teaching political science, Arkansas in the world economy, and the proposed constitution. Each roundtable panel will allow ample time for audience discussion.

All events will take place in the new convention center. APSA registration is just off the main lobby, as are rooms 2, 3, and 4, where all events are scheduled. The Old Mill, available for lunch on Friday, is adjacent to these rooms.

Special attractions at Fairfield Bay include the heated swimming pool and sauna (available from 6:00-9:00 a.m., noon till 7:00 p.m., and 9:00 p.m. till midnight), and fireplaces (supplied with wood) in the villa living rooms. As a private club, Fairfield Bay also has its own bar in the conference center. Other resort facilities include golf and tennis.

Rooming accommodations will be at the new villas, a few minutes' walk from the conference center. Each villa includes two bedrooms with private bath, color t.v., and two double beds; the bedrooms are separated by a living room which has a fireplace, cooking facilities, its own bath, and a sofa which makes into a double bed. Persons reserving a single room should indicate whether they prefer a bedroom or a living room. If a group of people wish to reserve a complete villa, they should so indicate on their reservation cards.

The "1 bedroom suite" includes a bedroom and living room, and the "2 bedroom suite" is a complete villa, as described above.

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When travelling to Fairfield Bay, it would be well to allow some extra travel time. The roads near Fairfield Bay are curving and mountainous and slow down one's driving pace considerably.

Please make your meal and room reservations by February 22, 1980. Room reservation cards should indicate who you're rooming with and what kind of accommodations.
