Committee members present were James Willis, Kurt Tweraser, Lawson Veasey, Gene Bigler, Bob Savage, Bill Nolan and Walter Nunn. Other Association members present were Jeddy LeVar, Diane Blair, Joel Anderson, Cal Ledbetter and Kenneth Walker.

Nunn reported that the APSA has \$29 in the treasury prior to the collection of registration fees and after the payment for the second issue of the Journal.

Anderson, editor of the Journal, reported that the second issue was completed and printed and that the manuscript for the third issue was almost ready to go to the press.

Savage, chairman of the Journal Review Committee, reported that it was felt that the Journal needed to be published at least semi-annually in order to develop a substantial subscription list. He said additional financing was needed to do so. He said there were three possibilities to pursue:

1. subvention by a campus.
2. a foundation grant.
3. a legislative appropriation like the one received by the Arkansas Historical Quarterly.

Ledbetter said although he was reluctant to do so, he could solicit enough \$100 contributions to acquire enough money to put out the third issue. The Executive Committee directed the Journal Review Committee to explore the possibility of subvention by a school.

The other committee chairmen reported very briefly.

The meeting adjourned.
