Present: Cal Ledbetter (president), Joel Anderson, Charles Hartwig, Norman Hodges, Simms McClintock, Jim Megginson, Walter Nunn, Kurt Tweraser, and James Willis.

Ledbetter opened the meeting at 12:30.

Nunn reported that APSA had \$527.69 in the treasury. He commended Ledbetter for raising \$1,125 for the Association.

Anderson reported that the APSA Journal should be issued in about four weeks. He recommended that after the third year APSA should review the Journal to evaluate it and decide whether to continue or revise the process. He said he hoped the Journal could be issued twice a year sometime in the future. He suggested reviewing such topics as editing, whether to confine it to Arkansas, confidentiality, and costs. Hartwig moved that the Association review the Journal after three years, and the motion was seconded and passed.

Ledbetter circulated an evaluation questionnaire about APSA for Board members to review prior to distribution to members at dinner tonight.

Ledbetter said a Newsletter editor and an APSA Directory editor were needed and that the new president would need to make those appointments.

The Executive Committee agreed to leave dues at \$10 for the coming year.

Hartwig reported the following recommendations of the Nominating Committee:

Willis said he'd send a copy of our program to PS.

Megginson said the Executive Committee would meet in Little Rock in April.

Hodges moved that papers published or presented elsewhere not be eligible for APSA awards, and the motion was seconded and passed.
